

BOARD OPERATIONAL GOALS

The board is committed to the education of all students consistent with their individual abilities, to a constant awareness of the concerns and desires of the whole community regarding the quality and efficiency of the school system and to the employment of a superintendent under whose leadership school personnel will carry out the policies of the board and meet district goals.

The board commits itself to the following objectives:

- A. To provide for the educational needs assessment of the community and to meet those needs through the formulation of policies and the setting of goals.
- B. To provide the necessary leadership to ensure that the goals and objectives of the school system can be effectively carried out.
- C. To maintain two-way communication with the various publics served by the schools.

It is the board's intent, working through the superintendent, to approach its responsibility for the operation of the school system by doing the following:

- A. Periodically setting performance objectives for the board and evaluating its accomplishments.
- B. Evaluating the superintendent's performance and reviewing the job description and functions at least annually.
- C. Setting new district goals annually and instituting procedures to evaluate results.
- D. Establishing an annual budget which will support normal operations and allow accomplishment of the new goals and objectives.
- E. Involving the community in board operation to the maximum extent possible.

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
