

ADVISORY COMMITTEES TO THE BOARD

The board encourages the participation of citizens in advisory committees; however, the legal responsibility for decision-making in all matters of policy and operation rests with the board.

- A. Board-appointed advisory committees will function within organizational frameworks approved by the board. A staff member or members will be assigned to each group to help it carry out its functions and coordinate its work with other advisory and staff groups. Only the board will have the authority to dissolve advisory committees it has created.
- B. Advisory committees that are required under federal and state programs will be formed, and will function, in accordance with the requirements pertaining to each specific program; the board will grant to those bodies the advisory responsibilities relevant to the program or project.
