

FUNDING PROPOSALS AND APPLICATIONS

The superintendent will apprise and the board may seek and utilize available federal, state and foundation grants which are consistent with the advancement of the educational program of the district and with the policies of the board in order to offer the best educational opportunities possible for children of the district.

The superintendent will submit proposals for all grants to the board under the section "Items for Board Consideration" on a meeting agenda for approval by the board before any action is taken that commits the district to the proposal. Care will be taken to point out future financial implications of grant acceptance by the district.

All applications for federal aid shall be prepared under the supervision of the superintendent and will be coordinated with the budgetary practices and capital improvement program of the district. Annually, the board shall authorize the superintendent and business manager to file applications and sign reports related to federal programs.
