

LIFE EDUCATION

The district recognizes that parents have the primary responsibility for the education of children in the area of human sexuality. The schools support the parents' efforts by offering students factual information and opportunities to discuss concerns, issues and attitudes inherent in family life and sexual behavior including traditional moral values.

In addition to the requirements listed below, the customary policies and curriculum regulations shall apply to any course dealing with Health and Family Living offered by the district:

- A. Instructional materials to be used in Health/Family Living will be available for inspection by the parent or guardian during school hours. These can be viewed at the child's school.
- B. If, after a conference with the principal, a parent requests that his/her child not participate in a given aspect of the course, an alternate educational assignment shall be arranged for the student with the approval of the principal.
- C. Teachers who provide instruction in Health/Family Living will have professional preparation in the subject area.
