

VISITORS TO THE SCHOOLS

The Board and staff of the district, welcome members of the community, and other interested persons to visit the district schools. School improvements often come from suggestions originating in such visits. All visitors must follow district policies and building procedures to ensure that such visits will enhance the effect of the educational program.

In order to assure that no unauthorized persons enter buildings with wrongful intent, all visitors must report to the school office and receive the building principal's permission to be on the school grounds. This policy does not apply when parents have been invited to a classroom or to a school-sponsored activity.

Any person on school property who has not registered with the school office will be requested to report to the building principal's office for permission to remain. Any request to be on school property for any purpose deemed by the building principal or his designee to be disruptive of the educational process will be denied permission to remain.

If a visitor refuses to leave the school grounds, creates any disturbance, or attempts to disrupt the educational process, the building principal or designee is directed to request aid from the local law enforcement agency.

Unauthorized persons shall not be permitted in school buildings or on school grounds. Building principals or designee are authorized to take appropriate action to prevent such persons from entering buildings and from loitering on grounds include the filing of criminal charges.
