

Goals for 2018-2019 School Year

Reading/Writing

- Implementation of a new reading curriculum
- Provide opportunities to meet student learning needs through intervention and enrichment
- Focus on writing across all content areas

Ways to help your child:

- ✓ Establish a reading time at home and read together or have your child read to others
- ✓ Encourage a written response when also talking about books they've read
- ✓ Ask questions about what they're learning in school
- ✓ Provide opportunities to explore your child's specific learning interests

Math

- Focus on specific teaching strategies that work
- Provide opportunities to meet student learning needs through intervention and enrichment

Ways to help your child:

- ✓ Ask your child to explain the math skills he/she is working on in school
- ✓ Play card or board games that involve counting or patterns
- ✓ Ask your child to explain how he/she came up with the answer on problems
- ✓ Point out ways that math is part of "real" life

Attendance

- 97% attendance for K-5th grade students

Ways to help your child:

- ✓ Establish a routine at home for waking up and bedtime
- ✓ Showing interest in student's school activities (conferences, family engagement nights, volunteering)
- ✓ Communicating with students' teachers
- ✓ Ask questions about what they're learning in school

PBIS

- Implementation of Morning Meetings with students
- Decrease classroom behaviors by building positive relationships

Ways to help your child:

- ✓ Setting up predictable routines at home
- ✓ Model the behavior you expect to see and reinforce it consistently
