

EMERGENCY LOCKDOWNS

In some emergency situations, an evacuation of a building and/or classroom is not advisable. These include a hostile intruder, hazardous release outside, terrorist attack or criminal activity near the school.

General emergency lockdown procedures are as follows:

COMMUNICATION

An emergency lockdown will be announced by intercom or other voice communication.

If a situation that may require an emergency lockdown is discovered, the individual making the discovery shall immediately contact police/security and provide as much information as possible.

Fire evacuation alarms are not to be sounded.

PROCEDURES

Lock classroom and other doors.

Close windows and window treatments if possible.

Turn off the lights.

Everyone is to remain quiet and not enter hallways.

Should the fire alarm sound, do not evacuate the building unless:

- You have first-hand knowledge that there is a fire in the building, or
- You have been advised by police/security to evacuate the building.

Move students out of sight from doors and windows.

Students in hallways are to seek shelter in the nearest classroom.

Students in outdoor areas should immediately take cover. If the threat is outdoors on campus grounds, all outdoor activities should be cancelled.

DRILLS

Lockdowns drills will take place once each semester and will not be announced as drills. Lockdown drills will be held without warning and shall be varied in procedure to

give the students the experience of different lockdown possibilities. The principal will provide the Buildings and Grounds Manager with a report on all lockdown drills.
