

EMERGENCY EVACUATION PLAN FOR HANDICAPPED STUDENT

Rapid City Area School District 51-4 recognizes the limitations presented by various types of disabilities, and the range of possible circumstances that could be presented by different types of disasters.

1. If circumstances require evacuation from the building, the disabled person is to evacuate the building by the safest and nearest exit and follow the general procedures for emergency evacuation.
2. If a disabled person is unable to evacuate without assistance, they may request that any available person assist them.
3. At the beginning of each academic year the special education teacher and building administrator or designee shall develop and post (below the Evacuation Plan in their classroom) a Personal Emergency Evacuation Plan (PEEP) for all disabled students currently enrolled in their classroom. This plan shall be updated periodically throughout the academic year as changes occur.
4. Personal Emergency Evacuation Plan will be referenced in Teacher Handbooks.

The above noted plan is intended to assist the appropriate authorities in evacuating disabled persons. If possible, evacuation will be conducted with input from, and at the direction of, the disabled person.
